In 2010, she was accepted into the Global Health Corps fellowship program and spent 1 year working at a clinic and community center in Burundi. Following this, Eva worked to establish One Acre Fund's program serving Burundi, which launched in 2011 and currently reaches nearly 50,000 farming households with locally delivered inputs, financing and training. She became Country Director in November of 2015 and General Partner for One Acre Fund in March 2016.
