Dan began his career in the U.S. Navy specializing in electronics and radar systems on board the USS Josephus Daniels. After six years of military service, Dan launched his civilian career in the field of electronics.

With creativity, entrepreneurial aspirations and electronics knowledge, Dan and his partner founded ABL Electronics which manufactured, imported, and distributed computer and network connectivity products. Their fledgling company, started in 1981 with a \$100 investment, grew to become a multi-million dollar international corporation recognized several times by The INC. 500: America's Fastest Growing Private Companies.

Some notable accomplishments of Dan's 30-year career are his three design patents for telecommunications connectivity products and his on-going international mission efforts, supporting the construction of housing units for families and orphans in Ukraine, Haiti, and India.

One of Dan's most recent pursuits has been the 2013 launch of the SVE Alumni Association where he has served as president since its inception. The SVEAA exists to create a lasting relationship between the school and its alumni, and to elicit the participation and support of alumni to further advance the school through fundraising for scholarships. To date, and under Dan's leadership, the SVEAA has proudly awarded \$48,000 in scholarships to 29 seniors pursuing college, university and technical school education.
